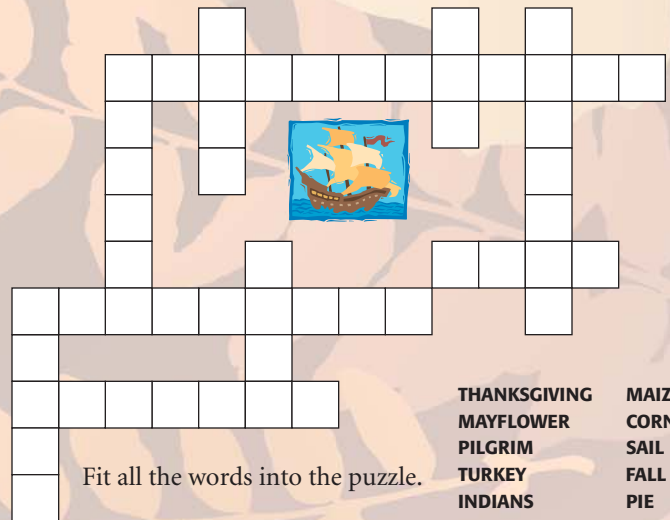

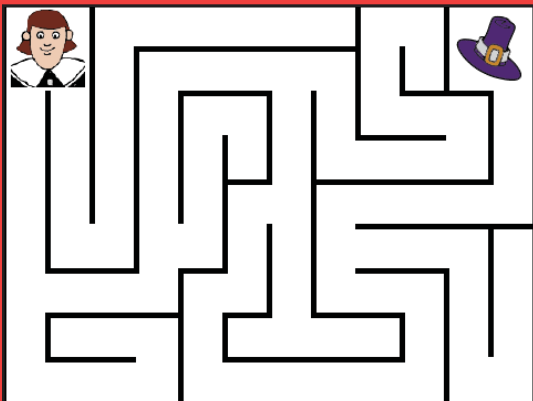
Thanksgiving Crossword
