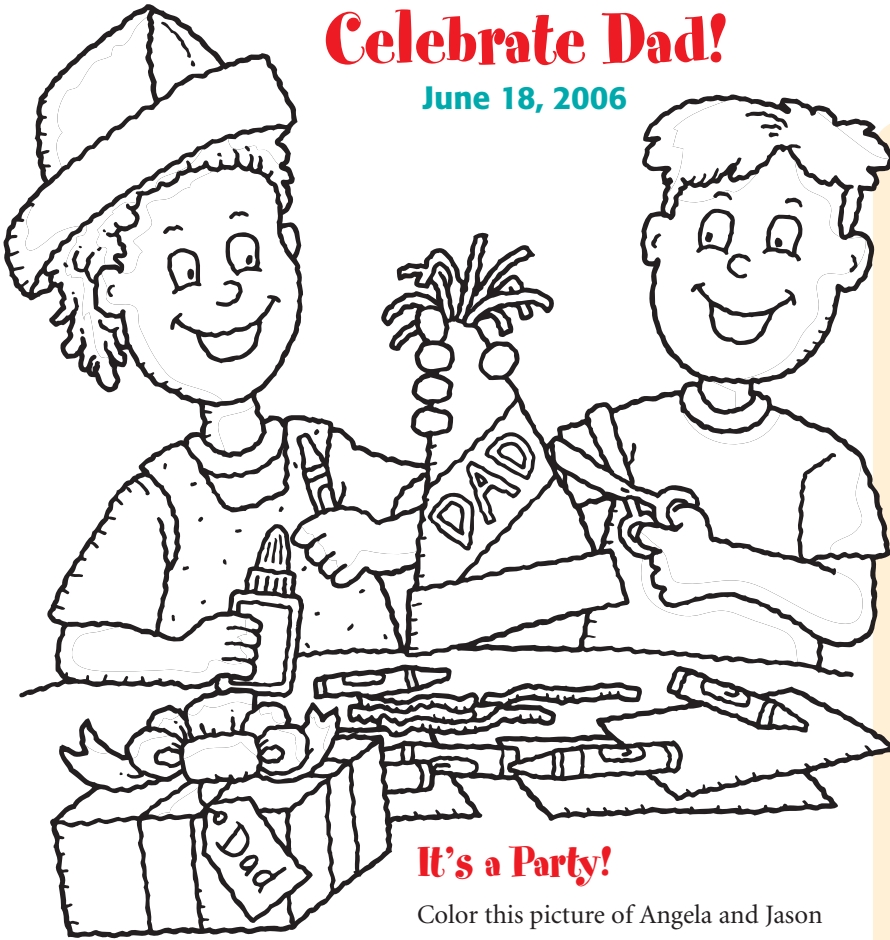

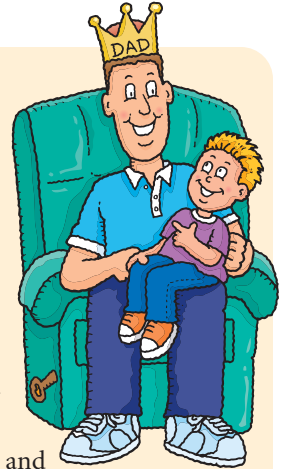


## It's a Party!

## Father's Day Facts

The first Father's Day in the United States was observed on June 19, 1910, in Spokane, Washington. The idea was proposed by Sonora Smart Dodd in 1909. Her father, William Jackson Smart, raised six children by himself after his wife died. He was a farmer and a civil war veteran. Sonora chose June 19th as the day to celebrate Father's Day because her father's birthday was in June.



It was in 1966 that President Lyndon B. Johnson officially proclaimed Father's Day a national holiday in the United States, and in 1972, it was declared an annual event.

Most people around the world have a day to honor dads, but some countries celebrate at different times of the year. In the United States, Father's Day is observed on the third Sunday in June.
